International Student Programs

The ISP Office of HIU is dedicated to helping international students adjust to Southern California culture. We provide conversation partners and regular opportunities to connect with the fellow international students as well as the entire student body. The ISP office leads students on memorable field trips to popular amusement parks, museums, local attractions and events. Because of our Southern California location in the heart of Orange County, we are able to offer extraordinary extra-curricular activities that are uniquely SoCal. We also advise students on applying for social security numbers and driver's licenses, opening bank accounts, navigating the transportation system, and more so they can get the most out of their study abroad experience.



HIU's College of Education provides English language training for international students seeking a study abroad experience in America, preparing them to pass the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and enter an American university. International students received highly personalized attention and guidance, and they often form lasting friendships with HIU students and professors.

HIU's Online Degree Programs

HIU's online programs are designed to meet the needs of working adults and accommodate their busy schedules. Our innovative online format provides a rich learning environment where professors and students can interact through discussion forums, conversation streams, and real time chats. It truly is a unique and efficient way to earn a college degree.

Our 8-week online courses offer start dates throughout the year, and are accessible any time of day using any internet-connected computer or mobile device. HIU's online programs are offered through Canvas™, an industry leader in online education that provides state-of-the-art, user-friendly online learning platforms.

HIU's online degree programs blend the flexibility of online learning with the feel of a classroom experience. Students watch lectures and complete individual assignments on their own schedules, but also spend a considerable amount of time interacting with other students, largely through online discussions. This interaction creates consistency, accountability, and builds community. HIU students enjoy building relationships with their peers and receiving personal attention from experienced faculty. HIU's online programs maintain small class sizes, allowing for personal attention and individualized instruction that creates optimal learning.

Navigating through college can be complicated at times. That's why we assign each HIU online student an Academic Coach to assist with paperwork, course selection and scheduling, provide advice on graduate school or career planning, and any other assistance a student may need along the way.

Through FAST TRACK, undergraduate students are able to take up to nine units of graduate coursework, called "transitional courses," that will apply toward a bachelor's degree as well as a future master's degree. Depending on the program, these nine units may equal a quarter of the graduate degree requirements, saving you precious time and money!

HIU's online classes gave me the flexible schedule that I needed to complete my degree.
